



Mildly Ill Campers Policy

105 CMR 430.159 (B) (2): Prior to admitting a child to the camp, parents and guardians shall be provided a copy of the policy pertaining to the care of mildly ill campers, administration of medication and the procedures for providing emergency health care. A complete copy of the policy shall be furnished to parents and guardians upon their request.

Mildly Ill Campers: Campers with symptoms of illness should report their symptoms to their counselors. The counselors will then alert the medical director and/or medical assistant who will further evaluate those symptoms. If the child appears too uncomfortable/ill to finish the camp day, the parents or guardians will be called, and the child should be picked up. The child should not return to camp until symptoms have improved.

Administration of Medication: Campers who require or may require medication(s) during the camp day will be required to have an administration of medication form filled out by their parent/guardian. Beverly Recreation Department's appointed health care supervisors will be allowed to administer medication to campers who require it. 105 CMR 430.160 will be adhered to and protocols in the Health Care Policy will be followed.

Providing Emergency Care: In an emergency situation, the camper should alert their counselor. The counselor should then alert the medical staff and/or call 911 if necessary. The parents/guardians of the camper involved will be made aware of the situation as soon as possible. Protocols in the Health Care Policy will be followed.
